INTRODUCTION

Accrington Stanley is one of footballs' oldest names and was among the twelve founder members of the EFL. A long-established club within the North West, their stadium accommodates 5,000 with on-site hospitality and training ground.

In 2014, management identified the need to review the current CCTV system and look at ways in which ease of use and image clarity could be improved upon to support their position as the only league two football club who don't require police presence on match days.

Selection Process

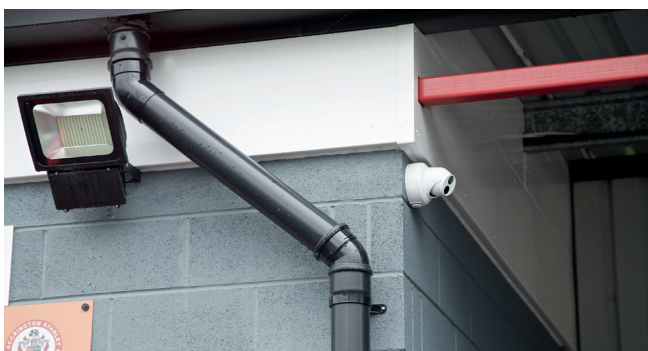
Managing Director, David Burgess was initially introduced to Guide Security by Accrington Stanley's Chairman Andy Holt who has been a valued client of Guide Security for many years.

Installation and Equipment

David continues, 'The installation process was seamless. The engineers were obviously well briefed and fully understood the requirements and quite simply got on with the job. They kept us informed and crucially made us aware of any potential down time. In total, the installation took ten days and the team even attended the first match to ensure that the system performed as expected. Overall, the new system is more user-friendly and provides a better clarity of image compared to the original.'



'The introduction of IP technology over the original analogue has provided us with instant playback and remote access to cameras via a tablet so we can keep an eye on everything. Any minor or significant

issues can be dealt with swiftly via a quick call to our own security team, Guide Security or indeed the police.'

Match-Day Management

The new security system offers huge benefits to Accrington Stanley by enhancing the working ability of the match day management team. David explains, 'On a match day we can have up to 4,000 people and can now manage this with confidence due to having a fully operational control room synchronising with our stewards.'

'Another issue solved by Guide Security is the ability to prevent the football club from receiving unnecessary fines. The new cameras offer colour images that provide a level of clarity which enables us to pick out individuals who may have set off flares or who are involved in anti-social behaviour,' says David. 'This evidence can be shared with the individual or group in question and handed over to the police for more serious offences.'

Accrington Stanley are extremely proud of their status as the only league two club allowed to host matches without a police presence. 'It is here that the CCTV becomes an integral part of our team,' David states. 'Typically, a club our size would spend as much as £12,000 per match on policing. The lack of incidents on match days is down to our match day management team working hand in hand with the CCTV system. This combination offers not only operational benefits, but also financial.'
